

Bling Dynasty

Global pop and consumer culture collide with traditional Chinese art in this upcoming exhibition. Titled Bling Dynasty, this playful showcase features a series of new works by Hong Kong-based artist Ernest Chang created using techniques drawn from Western and Chinese art and handcraft traditions. Expect silkscreen prints on plexiglass, resin and bronze sculptures, as well as traditional embroidery and calligraphy.
